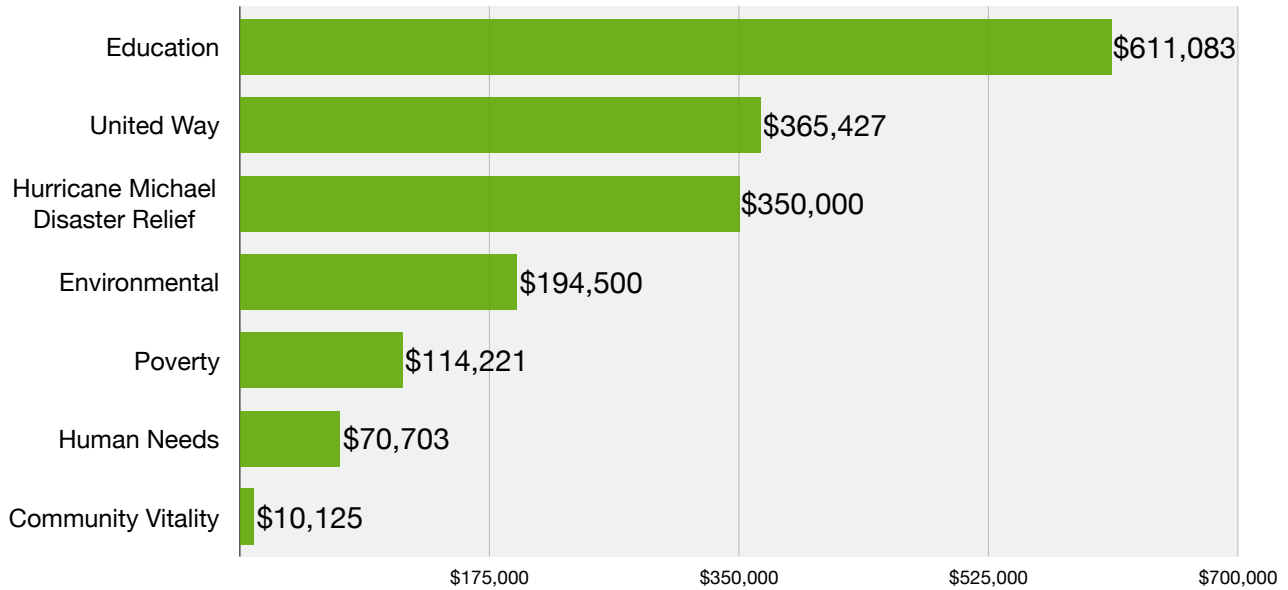

As we continue to grow and rebuild in our communities, these and future contributions being made across Gulf Power's service territory will make a difference for all who live, work and play in Northwest Florida.

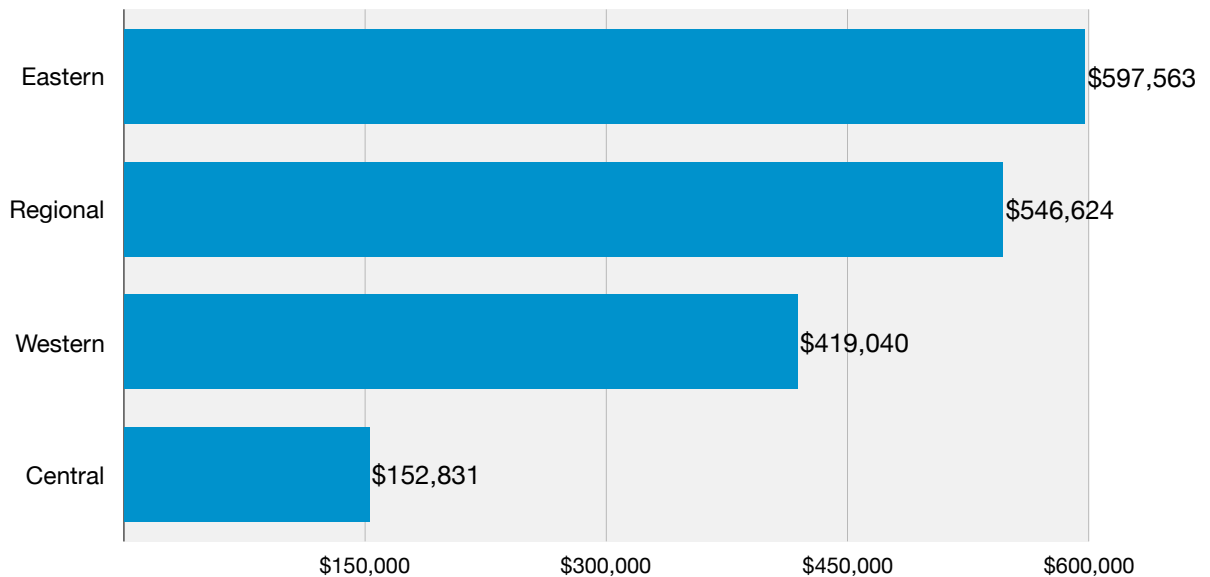
Foundation assets as of Dec. 31, 2018 – \$6,275,584.48
